Forty-eight players from five states competed in our largest tournament to date. It was our largest tourney, not just because 48 players competed in our 16' x 70' tap room. But also because it was our first tourney with four boards. We had two boards inside & two boards outside under a tent. Inside was our House Board & a beautiful 9-year old Venture Board we picked up in February. It was a 20 footer in someone's climate controlled basement, eleven miles from the bar. It was played less than 50 times in nine years. What a find! Outside, we had the resurfaced J & C Board & the original Ivy Inn Board. Miller Lite was our gracious sponsor for the weekend, so all Miller products were discounted. They also donated hats & shirts for every competitor. Winners received even more prizes.

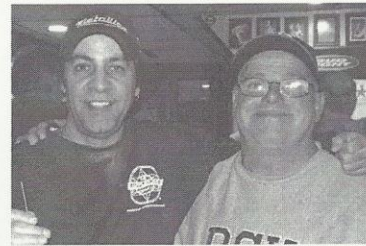

The action began early for Saturday's Bring Partner Tournament. Some of the 23 teams filtered in as early as 9am. The largest calcutta in Ivy Inn history rolled off at 11:20am & the first games of the day commenced just after noon. As the tourney evolved, twelve games were played on the 20 Footer. The House Board, the J & C Board and the Ivy Inn Board had seen eleven games each. There were a few surprises too. The final four on the winners bracket side saw the two lowest calcuttas & the two highest. Eventually, the team with largest calcutta Curtis Dean & Louise Williams, won the winners bracket. They still needed 1 more win to close it out. That's where they met Cid Floriani & Mike Kennedy. Cid & Mike won their first 2 games of the day, before Curtis & Louise sent them to the losers bracket. They then won five more games to find themselves in a re-match for the Championship. This game was played on the 20 Footer & lasted over an hour. Great shots were made by each team, but Cid & Mike got payback for the earlier loss to Curtis & Louise. It's now Midnight, and the final game of the Tournament moved outside to the J & C Board. That's where Cid & Mike capped off a seven-game win streak to take this year's Miller Lite Open. Some of the best shooters on the East Coast competed at the Ivy this day. But, it was the great performance by Floriani & Kennedy people will remember. Congrats to them on a wonderful tournament!

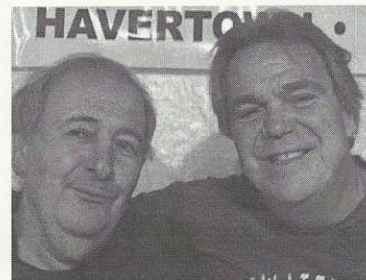
